Who are carers?

A carer is someone who provides unpaid care and support to a family member or friend who has a disability, mental or physical illness, substance misuse issue, or who needs extra help as they grow older.

Many carers do not identify themselves as carers for various reasons. Most feel they are doing what anyone else would do in the same situation, looking after their mother, son or best friend and just getting on with it.

There are an estimated 68,000 unpaid carers in East Sussex with an additional 34,000 carers because of the Coronavirus pandemic.

- Carers are the largest source of care and support in the UK.
- Every day, **6,000 people in the UK** take on a caring responsibility
- In East Sussex alone carers save an estimated £1,319,275,944 from the local economy by taking the pressure off local authority and NHS services.
- It is in everyone's interest that they are supported.

The East Sussex Carers Card has three functions:

- Identifies a carer in an emergency
- Provides an Emergency Respite plan (the CRESS card)
- Gives discounts and special offers to carers
