Purpose of role	To support the Community Development Worker to promote Care for the Carers at public events
What will you be doing?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attending public events such as fetes, fairs, fundraising events and community projects to promote the work of Care for the Carers • Talking to members of the public about Care for the Carers • Setting up and taking down the Care for the Carers stand • Working with the Community Development Worker to plan engaging stands and identify suitable events to attend
What skills, experience, qualities do you need?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A commitment to the vision and mission of Care for the Carers • A desire to support unpaid carers • Excellent communication skills • Confident speaking to members of the public • Reliable and trustworthy
What support will you get?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comprehensive training and induction programme • Opportunities for further learning and development as appropriate • Regular support and guidance from the Volunteer Coordinator • Expenses paid (in line with Care for the Carers policies)
What could you get out of it?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The chance to learn new skills

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet new, diverse people, be part of a welcoming and supportive organisation and a volunteering community • Enjoyment and a sense of achievement – volunteering is good for your well-being • Gain experience for related roles and courses • Use your skills and life experiences to support others • Opportunities for further training and expanding knowledge • Opportunities to get involved with other Care for the Carer services and events • A reference for future roles and employment
Other Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All volunteers are expected to abide by Care for the Carer policies and procedures • All volunteers will be asked to attend an informal interview and provide references • All volunteers must undertake a DBS check (paid for by Care for the Carers) • Day to day management for this role is undertaken by the Community Development Worker • Events take place across the whole of East Sussex so your own transport (or ability to access the events) is essential. Travel expenses will be reimbursed • Events can be outdoors and often at weekends • This role may sometimes require you to lift and move tables, chairs etc and set up a 'stand' that includes a gazebo. If you have any concerns about this please discuss with us so we can make reasonable adjustments to the role
